REGULATIONS ON THE SCIENTIFIC SCHOOL

1. General Provisions

- 1.1. A Scientific School (hereinafter referred to as the School) is a group engaged in one or several research topics, consisting of postgraduate students and students of Jalal-Abad State University or from outside the university.
- 1.2. The Scientific School (SS) may have one or several supervisors, depending on the subject areas.
- 1.3. When the SS works on several research topics, a general unifying theme must be established to connect them.
- 1.4. The main requirement is that the general manager, who leads the overall theme of the SS, must be employed at Jalal-Abad State University (JASU).
- 1.5. The SS carries out its activities in accordance with the laws and regulatory acts of the Kyrgyz Republic.
- 1.6. The SS is established by the decision of the Academic Council of JASU in accordance with these Regulations, approved by the Rector's order and confirmed by a special certificate.
- 1.7. The main objective of the SS is the training of scientific personnel in the specified research areas.

2. Structure and Activities of the Scientific School

- 2.1. The SS may include several scientific laboratories according to research directions.
- 2.2. The main requirement is the presence of at least one Doctor of Science and two Candidates of Science who have been trained under their supervision or are representatives of other scientific schools in related fields.
- 2.3. The SS carries out its activities on the basis of a specially issued work assignment.
- 2.4. The SS operates under the supervision of the Vice-Rector for Research and Innovation of the University.
- 2.5. The SS may conduct its activities independently or under special agreements concluded with the University with various institutions, organizations, and private individuals.
- 2.6. The main performance indicators of the SS include:
 - seminars held according to the SS work schedule;
 - participation in symposia and round tables;
 - publications in scientific journals (RINC, Scopus, etc.) with a non-zero impact factor;
 - publication of scientific monographs based on research results;
 - implementation of fundamental and applied research related to the approved topics.

3. Funding of the Scientific School

- 3.1. The SS is financed through research projects, university, international, or government grants, as well as private sponsors and patrons.
- 3.2. Research financed by the University is carried out by decision of the Academic Council (hereinafter – AC) only when the relevance of the topic and its practical value are established.
- 3.3. Scholarships for one year or several months may be awarded to staff members performing significant research work on the topic. Before the scholarship is granted, the research undergoes a special review.
- 3.4. Depending on the relevance of the SS laboratory's research, the University provides special equipment and resources, or funding is requested from the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic.
- 3.5. The financial activities of the SS funded by the University are reviewed and approved by the University Executive Committee.
- 3.6. Reports on the scientific results and financial expenditures of the SS are also reviewed by the Organizing Committee.
