**REGULATIONS**

**ON THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS (SDGs) COMMITTEE  
OF JALAL-ABAD STATE UNIVERSITY NAMED AFTER B.OSMONOV**

## 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

**1.1.** The Sustainable Development Committee (hereinafter referred to as the “*Committee*”) is a permanent advisory and coordinating governing body in the field of ESG (Environmental, Social, Governance) and sustainable development at *Jalal-Abad State University named after B. Osmonov* (hereinafter referred to as the “*University*”).

### 1.2. Purpose of Activity:

The systematic integration of the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) into all University processes, including educational programmes, research activities, campus operations, and social partnerships.

**1.3.** The Committee ensures the maintenance of a balance between economic performance, social responsibility, and environmental sustainability of the University.

### 1.4. Regulatory and Legal Framework:

- Legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic;
- National Sustainable Development Strategy of the Kyrgyz Republic;
- Charter and Development Strategy of Jalal-Abad State University named after B. Osmonov;
- International principles of sustainable development and ESG;
- Internal regulatory documents.

### 1.5. Principles of Activity:

- **Inclusiveness:** consideration of the interests of all stakeholders (students, staff, government, and business sector);
- **Digitalization:** application of a data-driven approach to monitor environmental impact and social metrics;
- **Transparency:** openness of data regarding the University’s impact on the regional ecosystem;
- **Systematic Approach and Measurability:** personal accountability for achieving specific KPIs.

## 2. MISSION AND STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

### 2.1. Mission:

To position the University as a leading regional center for sustainable development, integrating education, research, and innovation for the benefit of society and future generations.

## 2.2. Strategic Priorities:

- integration of the SDGs into all academic programmes;
- advancement of research in sustainable development, sustainable natural resource management, and green technologies;
- environmental modernization of the campus (Green Campus);
- promotion of social inclusion and human capital development;
- integration of ESG principles into the system of corporate governance;
- enhancement of the University's international reputation.

## 3. KEY TASKS AND FUNCTIONS

The Committee ensures the implementation of the following functions:

- **Strategic Planning:** development and regular update of the ESG Roadmap 2030;
- **Integration into Education:** methodological support and monitoring of the integration of sustainable development modules into 100% of academic programmes;
- **Advancement of Research in Sustainable Development:** support for R&D projects in alternative energy, water resource management, environmentally sustainable agriculture, and waste management;
- **ESG Reporting:** preparation of an annual public Integrated Report in accordance with international standards, aimed at improving the University's performance in the QS Sustainability Rankings and THE Impact Rankings;
- **Operational Monitoring:** coordination of campus environmental initiatives and monitoring of social indicators (inclusion, gender equality, and well-being);
- **Stakeholder Engagement:** development of partnerships with government bodies, the private sector, and civil society organizations for the joint implementation of social and environmental initiatives.

## 4. COMPOSITION AND GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

### Committee Leadership

**Chair of the Committee:** Rector of the University

- defines strategic priorities and key areas of the University's development;
- makes key managerial decisions;
- represents the Committee in relations with internal and external stakeholders.

**Deputy Chair:** Vice-Rector for State Language, Social and Educational Affairs

- provides operational management of the Committee's activities;

- coordinates cross-functional interaction and oversees the implementation of Committee decisions;
- monitors the achievement of target indicators.

**Executive Body: Sector for International Rankings**

- collection, verification, and analysis of data on key performance indicators (KPIs);
- preparation of reports;
- preparation of materials for Committee meetings;
- methodological support for strategic planning processes;
- support for internal monitoring and performance evaluation processes.

**Permanent Members of the Committee**

**Administrative and Management Staff (heads of departments, divisions, and units):**

- development and implementation of action plans in line with the approved strategy;
- integration of strategic objectives into operational processes of respective units;
- participation in the development and revision of internal regulatory documents.

**Academic Units (directors of institutes and colleges):**

- integration of strategic objectives into educational, research, and project activities;
- ensuring the engagement of academic staff in the implementation of the strategy;
- development of academic programmes in line with strategic priorities.

**5. ORGANIZATION OF ACTIVITIES AND WORKING BODIES**

**Regulations:**

Meetings of the Committee shall be held at least once per quarter. A quorum shall consist of more than 50% of the members. Decisions shall be adopted by a majority vote and formalized in meeting minutes. Extraordinary meetings may be convened to address urgent ESG-related matters.

**Reporting:**

The Committee shall report annually to the Academic Council of the University.

**Permanent Working Groups:**

- **Green Campus Team:** technical modernization, energy audits, campus greening, waste management, and water conservation;
- **Curriculum Lab:** integration of SDG principles into course content and academic programmes;
- **Social Equity Group:** issues of inclusion, scholarship support, mental health, and gender equality;
- **External Relations:** cooperation with international organizations, participation in sustainability rankings, and engagement with donors.

## **6. RIGHTS AND AUTHORITY**

The Committee is vested with the authority to:

- reject internal projects that contradict the principles of sustainable development;
- request verified data from all structural units for reporting purposes;
- represent the University at international climate, educational, and ESG-related forums.

## **7. RESPONSIBILITY**

### **7.1. General Provisions**

- Members of the Committee are responsible for the timely implementation and achievement of key performance indicators (KPIs) within their respective areas of responsibility;
- Members of the Committee are responsible for effective coordination and high-quality execution of tasks within their assigned areas;
- Heads of structural units are responsible for the timely and effective implementation of the Committee's decisions within their respective units.

### **7.2. ESG Performance Indicators**

- the University's position in national and international ESG rankings;
- percentage reduction in energy consumption, water usage, and CO<sub>2</sub> emissions;
- proportion of graduates whose competencies align with the requirements of the green economy and sustainable development;
- volume of attracted grants and investments for sustainable development projects.

## **8. FINAL PROVISIONS**

- These Regulations shall enter into force upon approval by the Rector of the University;
- Amendments and additions shall be made in accordance with the established procedure;
- Oversight of the implementation of these Regulations shall be assigned to the Chair of the Committee.
